To provide a platform for multiple voices and interpretations of Island, the British Council and curators Caruso St John Architects and artist Marcus Taylor have invited cultural and arts organisations to create a vibrant programme at the British Pavilion, alongside specially commissioned work by international and local artists, musicians and performers.

The British Pavilion will collaborate with the French Pavilion on a programme with Les Grands Voisins, participants of 'Lieux Infinis'.

Les Grands Voisins have become an emblem of the possibilities for urban vitality, generosity and creativity through facilitating the cohabitation between groups of people from different social backgrounds in Paris. Members of the Les Grands Voisins team will take over the galleries of the British Pavilion and host an open discussion about themes engaging across both Pavilions.
