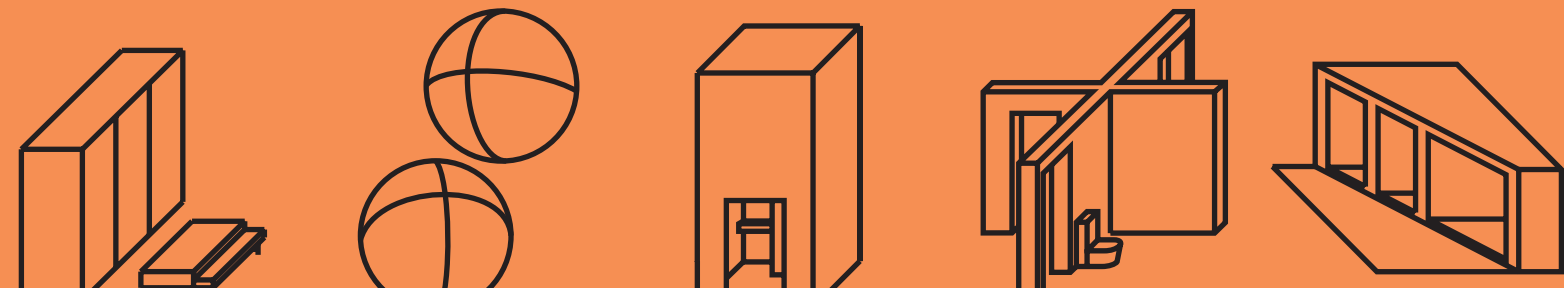

	- "I think the sharing clothes idea takes over the exhibition idea a lot"
	- "It's quite a communist idea"
	+ "We love the ideas and could see them in Paris, no problem with the French culture, it's a little utopian"
	+ "The spaces are being used already, I could see them working in Germany too"
	+ "I already share with with my housemates" - "No Privacy" - "I'm not ready to share my clothes" - "Nobody shares anything these days, they don't even talk to one another" - "I like the sharing idea but a similar model had an opposite effect in Russia"
	- "It's a bit extreme but maybe for the future" - "Maybe I could spend 8 hours in there if I was sleeping but not days" - "Not days, maybe hours" - "I could maybe spend a day in there if I had a book and a drink" - "It's a bit hot to spend days in"
	+ "You could easily spend 3-4 months here" + "You easily have enough space in in there" - "How do you accommodate disabled people?" - "The layout in the drawings gives a false economy as the square footage could be better adapted" - "It could hinder individual identity"
	+ "The idea is much stronger than the exhibit and is a great provocation" - "I'm not sure how neutral the space is with the diagonal. I'm interested in the research behind it."
	"The housing guidelines are restrictive to flexible living spaces, there are minimum requirements for studio apartments and dwellings so can be difficult for new inventive housing models to succeed, perhaps we need the regulations to be relaxed and let the designers prosper?"
	"They're all possible but people need to change. It requires good neighbours, I have bad neighbours at home and they don't care and do not share or respect the shared land"
	- "It depends on the culture, in Ireland it definitely wouldn't work"
	+ "I really like the idea of the decades room, the rooms are more about ideas than architecture"
	You can see how the different proposals could relate to different stages or ages in your life, moving through different models at varying phases in your life
	"They are all possible but people have to change first"
	+ "The kitchen is far too small"
	"We have a similar situation in Zurich with prices and we would definitely try new models"
	"In New York there is no real estate left, we have a similar situation where the gap to buy a house is too big. We would live in a small well designed space to get on the ladder. In New York you don't need a kitchen because you have 100 food vendors on your block alone"
